There Is Still Time to Be Vaccinated for Flu

Anyone who has not been immunized for flu may come to any of the final clinics offered by the Central Connecticut Health District. Everyone age 4 and older is invited, regardless of town of residence. Both nasal spray and injections are available. We will bill **all Anthem, ConnectiCare, and Medicare Part B insurance plans**, as well as **Aetna Medicare (PFFS only) and Health Net Medicare Plans**. Participants must bring the card from one of the these plans to the clinic to receive their flu vaccination at no charge. People covered by all other insurance plans will be charged \$25 and a receipt will be given. The Health District is pleased to announce that uninsured persons can now receive a **FREE** flu vaccination this year thanks to grant money awarded to the Health District..

The Central Connecticut Health District will hold flu vaccination clinics at the Wethersfield Town Hall, 505 Silas Deane Highway, Wethersfield on the following dates:
