CHAPTER 157. HYDRANTS

Article II. Snow and Ice Removal

[Adopted 4-16-1984 by Ord. No. 115-84]

§ 157-6. Removal required.

All snow and ice accumulating in the street higher than a point four inches below the bottom of the lowest outlet on any fire hydrant and within a radius of three feet from the center of such hydrant shall be removed by the tenant, occupant, owner or agent of the premises fronting on that portion of the street within six hours of daylight after such snow and ice has ceased to fall or accumulate, and within six hours after sunrise when the same has fallen in the nighttime, and such tenant, occupant, owner or agent shall clear a path having a minimum width of three feet between any fire hydrant and the edge of the traveled portion of the abutting street or highway.

§ 157-7. Penalties for offenses.

Any tenant, occupant owner or agent of any premises whose duty it is to clear the sidewalk adjacent thereto and who violates any of the provisions of § **157-6** or refuses or neglects to comply with the same shall be fined the sum of \$90 for each day of neglect or refusal to comply with any of the provisions of said section.
