

Skatepark Rules And Regulations

1. This facility is used by both experienced and inexperienced skateboard/in-line skaters. Serious injury may result from being hit by skateboard, falling or colliding. The Town of Rocky Hill does not assume responsibility for injuries – **SKATEBOARDING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
2. All skaters must be 9 years of age or older. Skaters under 11 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. All skaters must complete and sign a medical form and waiver prior to entering the facility.
4. All participants 17 years of age and under must have their parent or guardian complete and sign the medical and waiver form.
5. All skaters must wear the appropriate safety gear which includes: helmet, elbow pads, knee pads and wrist/hand guards.
6. All safety gear must be in good condition. Participants not wearing appropriate safety gear will not be allowed to skate.
7. Due to safety concerns, spectators who are not skating may not enter the park while activity is in progress. Spectators must remain outside the fence.
8. No smoking, drinking or drug use allowed.
9. Participants must abide by staff instructions at all times.
10. The Town of Rocky Hill reserves the right to change the schedule as Necessary – see posted hours of operation.
11. All forms of graffiti, tagging or other means of defacing Town property is strictly prohibited. Such activity will result in temporary closure of the facility, the arrest of the guilty party and a fine.
12. Only one skateboarder is permitted on a board at a time.
13. All skateboards and in-line skates must be in good repair.
14. Trespassers will be arrested and prosecuted.
