

DECK PERMIT APPLICANT INFORMATION

1. PERMIT APPLICANT IS RESPONSIBLE TO SATISFY ALL APPLICABLE DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:
 - a. Zoning Department
 - b. Health Department (wells and septic systems)
 - c. Authority Having Jurisdiction Sewer Department
 - d. Historical Department
 - e. Engineering / Wetlands Department

2. DECKS NOT EXCEEDING 200 SQUARE FEET IN AREA, that are **NOT MORE THAN 30 inches** above the grade (ground) at any point, **ARE NOT attached to a dwelling and DO NOT SERVE the exit door per code DO NOT REQUIRE A BUILDING PERMIT but STILL REQUIRE A ZONING PERMIT.**

3. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR DECK BUILDING PERMIT SUBMITTAL:
 - a. Property Map / Site / Plot Plan with LOCATION OF DECK drawn to scale, 2 sets.
 - b. Deck Plans, 2 sets
 - c. Deck Construction Questionnaire completed

4. INSPECTIONS REQUIRED:
 - a. Footing / Pier / Foundation support inspection PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF CONCRETE.
 - b. Deck Structure Rough Framing inspection.
 1. Guard Rail Post Installation.
 2. Concrete Slab 12 inches minimum depth forms under Stair Stringers structural support.
 3. DECK and STAIR Structure Sub-Framing prior to installation of Decking and Treads.
 - c. FINAL INSPECTION

5. SEPARATE ELECTRICAL PERMIT REQUIRED to install code required
 - a. electrical receptacle
 - b. exterior stair means of egress lighting
 - c. all other electrical provided devices


6. PRIOR to ALL WORK APPLICANT TO CONTACT "CALL BEFORE YOU DIG" at 1-(800) 922-4455.

7. Additional information shall be provided as requested by Building Official. Where special conditions exist, the Building Official is permitted to request additional information.




Deck Plan View
